

WHAT'S NEW IN KWKMF 2020?

NEW THINGS

- Elementary piano classes will continue to function like all other classes, just like 2019
- The accompanied class discount (4 classes for the price of 3) will continue this year!
- Classes increase by 50 cents per class (generally speaking - see syllabus)
- All chamber ensemble classes (non-school groups) are \$30 (see syllabus)
- The 2020 concerto competition is for winds/brass/voice. (2021 is for piano)
- Advertisements in the festival program can be purchased at \$100 each.

NEW ADJUSTMENTS AND UPDATES TO RULES

- Twenty-minute time limit on solo and chamber performances
 - This is particularly important for diploma piano
- Suzuki strings classes may play two selections if the total time if their selections is less than two minutes
- In the case of injury or compassion, credits for the following year's festival season may be offered in the same category and amount at the discretion of the committee
- All participants must provide a legal copy of their music for the adjudicator. Because the adjudicator must view the music in order to fairly award marks in competitive classes, participants who do not provide a score for the adjudicator will not be eligible for placement ribbons; a participant ribbon will be awarded to that competitor instead. (Please note that in duet and ensemble classes, photocopied scores for the performers or adjudicators are not permitted unless the score is in the public domain).
- Participants must announce their name, the title of their selection, and the name of the composer before performing their selection.

NEW PROCEDURES FOR ANNOUNCING CLASS RESULTS

The class results will be announced as follows: third place, second place, and finally first place as well as the first placement's seal of standard.

NEW PROCEDURE FOR PIANO QUARTET NIGHT

Unlike the past several years where all piano quartets performed one after each other regardless of begin in different classes, piano quartets will now run like all other classes. The recipients of the Diary Queen Award, the Second Top and the Top Quartet (recipient of the Ursula Yundt Memorial Trophy) will be announced at the end of the evening, and awards will be given out at the Finale Concert.
